SUSTAINABLE INNOVATION IN OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH

On April 24 and 25, a leading international meeting was held at the corporate building of La Segunda Seguros to discuss innovation and sustainability in occupational risk prevention. The insurance company from Rosario hosted the event organized by the ORP International Foundation.

This edition of LEAN ORP 2024 was held under the slogan "Sustainable Innovation in Occupational Safety and Health" and was attended by more than 400 participants from Latin America, most of whom are professionals in the prevention area of large and medium-sized companies and institutions.

The event was a milestone in the sector because it was the first time it was held in the country. The manager of La Segunda ART, Guillermo Meneguzzi, pointed out that "this is a milestone in our history as ART, to have 20 professional speakers, mostly from Europe, who came to Rosario in person.

to share their experiences is very interesting. And there is an important fact, in prevention there may be different legislations in each country, but prevention actions are the same for all. To prevent an accident is the same secret here, in Germany, in Spain, in the United States. That is why it is important to listen to different cases".

Within the innovation related to occupational risks, one of the key tools is the use of artificial intelligence (AI). The director of the ORP Foundation, Pedro Mondelo, explained in the framework of the meeting that "today all countries need to integrate technology in an accelerated way in the production processes because we are experiencing a truly revolutionary moment. AI is a revolution that will radically change the world of work, it will change everything, for example in the way we produce, the way we think, the way we act, the way we look for work, the way we offer work".

At the same time, he adds that from the irruption of this technology "people will save mechanical time to have a lot of time for reflection, they will break their routine of uninteresting work to open a new frontier of non-routine thinking. It will free up time to create and think. We are moving towards a more sensitive society in which we can recover time, that people are more people and less animals".

During the two days of LEAN ORP 2024, these topics were discussed, as well as different devices where IA was the protagonist were presented. There was also space for interactive sessions where attendees had the opportunity to exchange ideas, share best practices and establish professional networks.

THE AI: HOW DO WE GET ON BOARD THIS NEW WORLD REVOLUTION?

The Asunción International Summit brought together specialists in Artificial Intelligence (AI) who presented their knowledge to university students, professionals and the public interested in learning about this technology that has arrived to transform working life. Executives from the Polytechnic and Artistic University of Paraguay (UPAP) were specially invited to the event by the ORP Foundation.

The activity entitled "AI, how do we get on board this global revolution?" brought together Paraguayan and foreign experts who shared experiences on the impact of new technologies on the business world and society.

Dr. Pedro Mondelo, Director of the ORP Foundation, highlighted that AI is being used to solve complex problems, improve efficiency in business and make human life easier. "The integration of artificial intelligence raises crucial questions about data privacy, labor displacement and equity in access to technology," he said. The main co-reference of the day said that AI offers a

wide range of possibilities to which one must adapt, whether at work, at university or in everyday life. He added that we must be prepared "to provide solutions in the future".

"The idea of my presentation was to reflect on the impact of artificial intelligence in today's world, especially in two areas: in the workplace and in the training that new university students will need," said the Spanish specialist.

Dr. Pedro Mondelo pointed out that work will change radically in the near future, so the market will need different professionals. "For this we need the university to be ahead of the future," he said. In addition, he said that companies are currently handling new technologies and new methodologies. "They have new instruments or robots, we have to teach people how to use them and program them," he said.

Tatiena Klymchuk, Sabenti's Chief AI Officer, gave the following presentation "The boom of

the generative models: intuitive insights from ChatGPT for 2024," on evaluating AI and how to use it safely and responsibly.

"I think it's one of the fastest advancing technologies, every day, every second, every day I update my presentation because it may not be valid anymore. This is very difficult for us because we have to keep up with that pace. This is our future and we have to live with this," Klymchuk expressed.

Finally, Albert Puntí, Data Scientist, gave his lecture "Exploring the limits of digitalization with artificial intelligence", oriented to the business world.

"Today we only see the tip of the iceberg of what artificial intelligence will allow us to do. In the very near future there will be tools that make our day-to-day life much easier with tedious jobs that don't add value. In the medium term, I think we are going to adapt to this new technology," said Puntí.

DIGITIZATION OF SST: STRATEGIC PLANNING AND FORECASTING

Zaragoza hosted for two days the congress "Digitalization of OSH: Strategic Planning and Foresight", a training proposal with national and international presence that will address how to introduce new technologies to ensure safety at work.

The second vice-president and councilor of Economy, Employment and Industry of the Government of Aragon, Mar Vaquero, was in charge of inaugurating this congress. There she pointed out the importance of applying new technologies in the prevention of occupational risks with the aim of reaching the figure of zero injuries and fatalities, the "only valid" figure for the Executive. "Technology has come into our lives to change our way of proceeding and acting, and also to offer us possibilities that were unknown until a few dates ago", said the vice president.

That is why "occupational safety cannot remain oblivious to this reality and we also have to know how to take advantage of the benefits of today's world." "We cannot let our guard down with occupational safety," she stressed.

At the opening of the congress, in which more than 240 have registered, Mar Vaquero emphasized that this is the culmination of a few months in which the dissemination and awareness of occupational safety has had a significance "never known to date".

The congress "Digitalization of OSH: Strategic Planning and Foresight" is an event that brought together national and international specialists to explore the challenges and opportunities that the digital revolution presents in the field of occupational safety.

Digital transformation has changed radically change the way organizations manage occupational risks, imposing the need for strategic planning and a proactive vision.

In this context, the congress was presented as a crucial space to analyze how to adapt to these technological changes, which include artificial intelligence, data intelligence, technological convergence, the challenges of digitalization, cultural transformation, sustainability and business productivity to make the most of the options available in the present and the future.

SST INNOVATION IN THE DIGITAL ERA

Barcelona was setting for the Lean ORP 2024, an event that brought together more than 250 professionals of the Occupational Safety and Health sector. Organized by the Foundation

International ORP, the event focused on on "OSH Innovation in the Digital Age", highlighting the importance of digitalization to improve occupational safety management.

During the event, 48 speakers were featured, addressing critical issues in the field of technology and workplace wellness, highlighting the importance of ethical and human-centered integration of AI in the workplace.

Some of the key conclusions of the event were:

1. Ethical Use of Artificial Intelligence: Emphasis was placed on the need for the ethical use of artificial intelligence, promoting technologies that respect the privacy and dignity of the worker, while optimizing safety and efficiency without compromising human values.

2. Focusing People in the Organization: Experts agreed that people should be the focus of any organization.

This includes not only protecting their physical, ergonomic and mental health, but also promoting a work environment that contributes to overall well-being.

3. Sustainability and Environmental Protection: The importance of comprehensive sustainability was discussed, which involves operating in a way that protects the environment while ensuring economic viability and employee well-being.

4. Talent Loyalty and Humanized Leadership: Talent retention and the development of efficient and humanized leadership were crucial issues. The need for leaders who understand circadian rhythms and the effects of lighting on health, and who use that knowledge to improve working conditions, was highlighted.

5. Use of Data in Health Promotion: The importance of data analysis to achieve the objectives of a Healthy Company was another of the topics addressed. It was highlighted how an effective analysis can contribute to the prevention of occupational accidents and diseases.

6. Contribution to the Sustainable Development (SDGs): The congress also reinforced the commitment to the UN Sustainable Development Goals, focusing on how practices can be used to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). of work healthy and sustainable contribute to these global objectives.

7. Vision Zero Strategy: We addressed the Vision Zero strategy, which aims to reduce occupational accidents and illnesses to zero. This strategy emphasizes the need for an ongoing commitment to safety and health at all levels of the organization.

On the last day, a session was held at the Alba Synchrotron, where the importance of this unique infrastructure in Spain for the advanced study of the subject was highlighted, illustrating the intersection of cutting-edge science with industry and occupational health.

LEAN ORP Barcelona 2024 concluded with a call to action for companies, regardless of size, to adopt technologies and practices that prioritize human well-being and sustainable development, thus ensuring a healthier and more productive future for all workers.

THE IMPACT OF SUSTAINABILITY AT WORK

On Tuesday, October 22, the Universidad Autónoma de Chile hosted the III Business Forum, "The Impact of Sustainability at Work", an event in which leaders of large national and international companies discussed their experiences and other key issues in an increasingly globalized and competitive context.

Teodoro Ribera, Rector of the Universidad Autónoma de Chile, explained that "in such a changing world, the success of a company depends not only on economic success, but also on its internal policies and external relations so that it is valued by the environment and can put down deep roots that will enable it to sustain itself even in difficult times".

In this way, he added that "we have seen that they have raised sustainability from the financial point of view, -a company that If it does

not do well economically, it will go bankrupt, but it has also considered the relationship with the environment, how it has to relate to the surrounding communities (...) a company that does not care about its workers, that has very high accident rates, obviously has a problem".

At the event, it was stated that this approach not only focuses on reducing environmental impact through the use of clean energy and waste minimization, but also on promoting policies that balance the personal and professional lives of workers, generating fairer, healthier and more productive environments.

Gina Ocqueteau, director of SQM, stated that "the arrival of multinationals in Chile made us set high standards, the fact that we also belong to the OECD, to such a special club with very important indicators in these matters, has made

that we all jump on the bandwagon and I see more and more awareness of these issues among businessmen, not only the environmental issue, the financial issue, but also the issue of social value".

During the conference - organized by the Universidad Autónoma de Chile, together with Fundación Internacional ORP (Spain), the Chilean Safety Association, Adecco Chile and Reqlut - it was concluded that the implementation of these practices leads to significant benefits, such as an improvement in the quality of life of employees and greater operational efficiency.

ORP 2024 International Congress - Santiago de Chile held its 24th edition under the motto "Digitalization & Wellbeing: New Era for Prevention"



The 24th edition of the ORP International Congress, organized by the ORP International Foundation, kicked off last Wednesday, October 23rd at the Metropolitan Convention Center Auditorium in Santiago, with the central theme "Digitalization and Wellness: New Era for Prevention". This event brought together more than 160 speakers from around the world, consolidating itself as a global benchmark in Occupational Safety and Health in an environment marked by digital transformation and the advance artificial intelligence.

Amaro Gómez-Pablos, renowned journalist, was the master ceremonies during the opening ceremony, which featured speeches by industry leaders, including ORP Foundation President Hans-Horst Konkolewsky; ORP Congress Director Pedro R. Mondelo; General Manager of the Chilean Safety Association (ACHS), Juan Luis Moreno; and the Superintendent of Social Security (SUSESO), Pamela Gana.

The opening day's program included lectures by experts in artificial intelligence and its impact on the world of work, including Sergio Patrick Somerville of the World Bank, who addressed the role of AI in the

development of digital strategies, and Dr. Tetiana Klymchuk of Sabentis, who explored the new frontiers of generative AI in Occupational Safety and Health.

The event, which coincides with the European Week for Safety and Health at Work, continued for three days with activities that included working sessions and discussion tables in specialized rooms with simultaneous translation. It was also an opportunity to reward the best in its now traditional ORPHEUS Night, an awards gala held on October 24 where the most outstanding professionals and projects in the field of occupational prevention were recognized. Among the award winners were the Hospital Universitario San Ignacio and innovative projects such as Tuscany, in virtual reality. The individual awards went to Dr. Mohammed Azman Aziz Mohammed and Franco Dutto. In addition, the German Social Accident Insurance (DGUV) received the ORP 2024 International Award for its leadership in the "Vision Zero" initiative.

At the closing session, Amaro Gómez-Pablos, presenter of the event, expressed his gratitude to all the attendees and stressed the importance of knowledge sharing. in a global environment that demands safer workplaces that promote wellbeing. The closing program included a series of keynote lectures, including Rodrigo Montero on labor welfare and economics; Pablo Yáñez of Acciona, who presented a new paradigm in preventive management; Ignacio Fuentes of MIT's Jameel Clinic, who explored advances in generative artificial intelligence; and Fabia Silva of Dronak Robotics, who spoke about the impact of AI on automation and labor relations.

The event also included an ORP Talks space, where Amaro Gómez-Pablos and Mateo Valero, from the Barcelona Supercomputing Center, addressed the role of supercomputing, digital twins and artificial intelligence in the future of OSH.

In his closing remarks, the Rector of the Universidad Autónoma of Chile, Teodoro Ribera; the president of the ORP Foundation, Hans-Horst Konkolewsky; and the director of the ORP Foundation, Pedro R. Mondelo, highlighted the relevance of this initiative in advancing towards safe and sustainable labor practices. It was also announced that the next meeting will be held in Cartagena de Indias, Colombia, from July 30-31 to August 1, 2025, coinciding with the celebration of the 25th anniversary of the International ORP Foundation promoting innovation in occupational prevention.

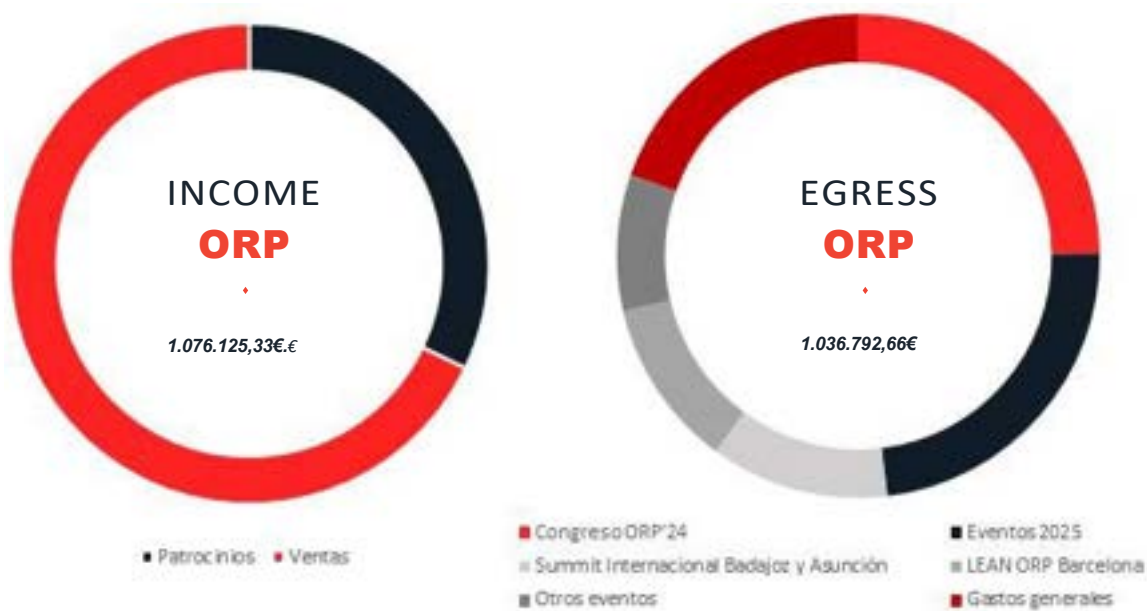

During 2024, total income amounted to **€1,076,125.33**. Of this amount, sponsorships from collaborating entities totaled €346,038.33, representing more than 32% of total income. On the other hand, sales reached €730,087.00, which is equivalent to 67% of the total income of the ORP International Foundation.

During 2024, total expenses amounted to **€1,036,792.66**. Of this amount, 257,659.08€ (25%) was allocated to the ORP'24 Congress, while 240,754.08€ (23%) was allocated to Events 2025. General expenses accounted for 202,781.45€ (20%). 124,102.82 (12%) were used for the BADAJOZ INTERNATIONAL SUMMIT and the ASUNCION INTERNATIONAL SUMMIT, and were allocated to LEAN ORP Barcelona. The rest of the expenses were distributed among other events.
